The availability of internships varies according to our programme cycle. We will keep your application form until an internship is available in the area of work you are interested in. Your form will then be considered and successful applicants will be invited for an interview. Unsuccessful applicants will be notified at this point. Due to demand, we cannot guarantee a placement will be available immediately, please state on your application form the time period for which you will be available. Please give as much relevant information as possible on your application form as we will use this to select candidates for interview.

The internship programme aims to provide volunteers with invaluable experience of working within a thriving arts environment, essential for placing yourself ahead of your peers. You will also receive free entry to VIVID events, invites to all Private Views and discounts on VIVID publications. A small allowance for travel and lunch expenses is available.

Vivid expects interns to have a clear interest in contemporary media and interdisciplinary art, familiarity with basic office technology, a willingness to adapt and work as part of a team and ability to use own initiative.
